COMPLETE RELEASE, WAIVER OF CLAIM, AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

IN CONSIDERATION of permission granted by Camp Kahquah to use the camp's property, facilities, amenities, and equipment (the "Facilities") now or in the future and to participate in activities sponsored or organized by the camp (the "Activities"), I, the undersigned, release Camp Kahquah and its employees, representatives, volunteers, and board members (collectively called "Camp Kahquah") from all liability and waive all recourse against Camp Kahquah for loss or damage that I may suffer or that my next of kin (or those in my care) may suffer as a result of my participation in the Activities carried out on and in the vicinity of the Facilities including the waterfront and dock adjacent to the Facilities (the "Waterfront"). I voluntarily accept the physical risk together with the legal risk, thereby expressly giving up any right of legal action.

I further acknowledge and agree:

1. To follow the rules and regulations established by Camp Kahquah.
2. That the Facilities are located in a natural setting which presents changes and variability in the terrain and weather as well as other unpredictable elements and, as a result, the Facilities and Activities may present certain risks, hazards, and dangers to my person and my property.
3. That no Waterfront supervision is provided by Camp Kahquah. Guests are expected to follow the guidelines provided for the use of the Waterfront.
4. That no medical or first aid personnel are provided by Camp Kahquah.
5. That some of the risks, hazards, and dangers mentioned above are foreseeable but others are not.
6. That I freely and voluntarily assume all risks, hazards and dangers and acknowledge that my use of Facilities and Waterfront is entirely at my own risk.
7. To leave the Facilities that I have used in a state similar to their condition upon arrival.
8. That Camp Kahquah does not permit pets of any kind. (If a disability requires the assistance of a service animal, please contact the Camp Administrator to make appropriate arrangements prior to your arrival).
9. That alcohol, tobacco, vaping, marijuana, and illegal drug use is strictly prohibited on the property of Camp Kahquah. Camp Kahquah has the right to dismiss anyone who does not follow this policy.
10. To conserve the natural beauty and man-made facilities of Camp Kahquah and refrain from disfiguring, defacing, damaging, or destroying the site.
11. That Camp Kahquah may use any image or likeness of myself (or those in my care) in order to promote the camp.
12. That I have carefully read and understand this COMPLETE RELEASE, WAIVER OF CLAIM, AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK.
13. That Camp Kahquah does not and will not permit me to participate in any program unless I sign this COMPLETE RELEASE, WAIVER OF CLAIM, AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK and that the terms of this Agreement need not be brought to my attention each time I participate in Activities in order to be effective.
14. That I am 18 years of age or older, and that all minors with me are expected to be under the care of a responsible adult.
15. To release Camp Kahquah from all liability, claims of action, loss, or damage arising out of my participation in the Activities carried out on and in the vicinity of the Facilities or Waterfront, however caused, and notwithstanding that such injury, damage, or loss to me or my property may have been contributed to or caused by the negligence of Camp Kahquah.

COVID-19

Given the current circumstances surrounding the novel coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 and the accompanying disease COVID-19, I acknowledge that there is inherently an increased risk to my and others' health in choosing to participate in events and activities outside of my own home. In addition to the aforementioned waiver, I agree to:

1. Release Camp Kahquah from any and all liability in the event that I or anyone in my household or under my care should contract COVID-19.
2. Complete the appropriate screening procedures and abide by the protective and disciplinary measures upheld by Camp Kahquah. These may include actions such as physical distancing, increased hand washing and sanitising, and vigilant cleaning and disinfecting.
3. Comply with federal, provincial, and municipal protocols and standards determined by public health professionals in order to reduce the risk of transmission.
