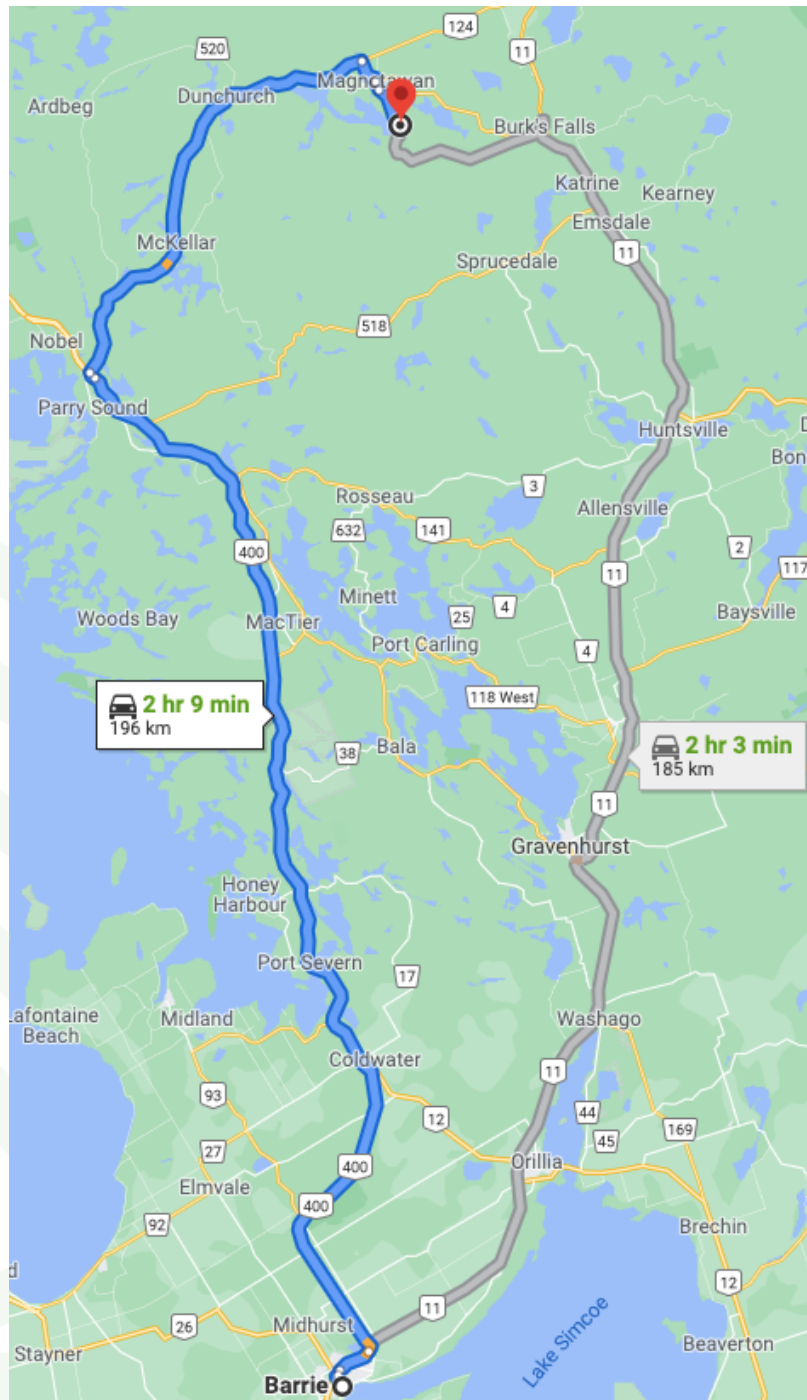
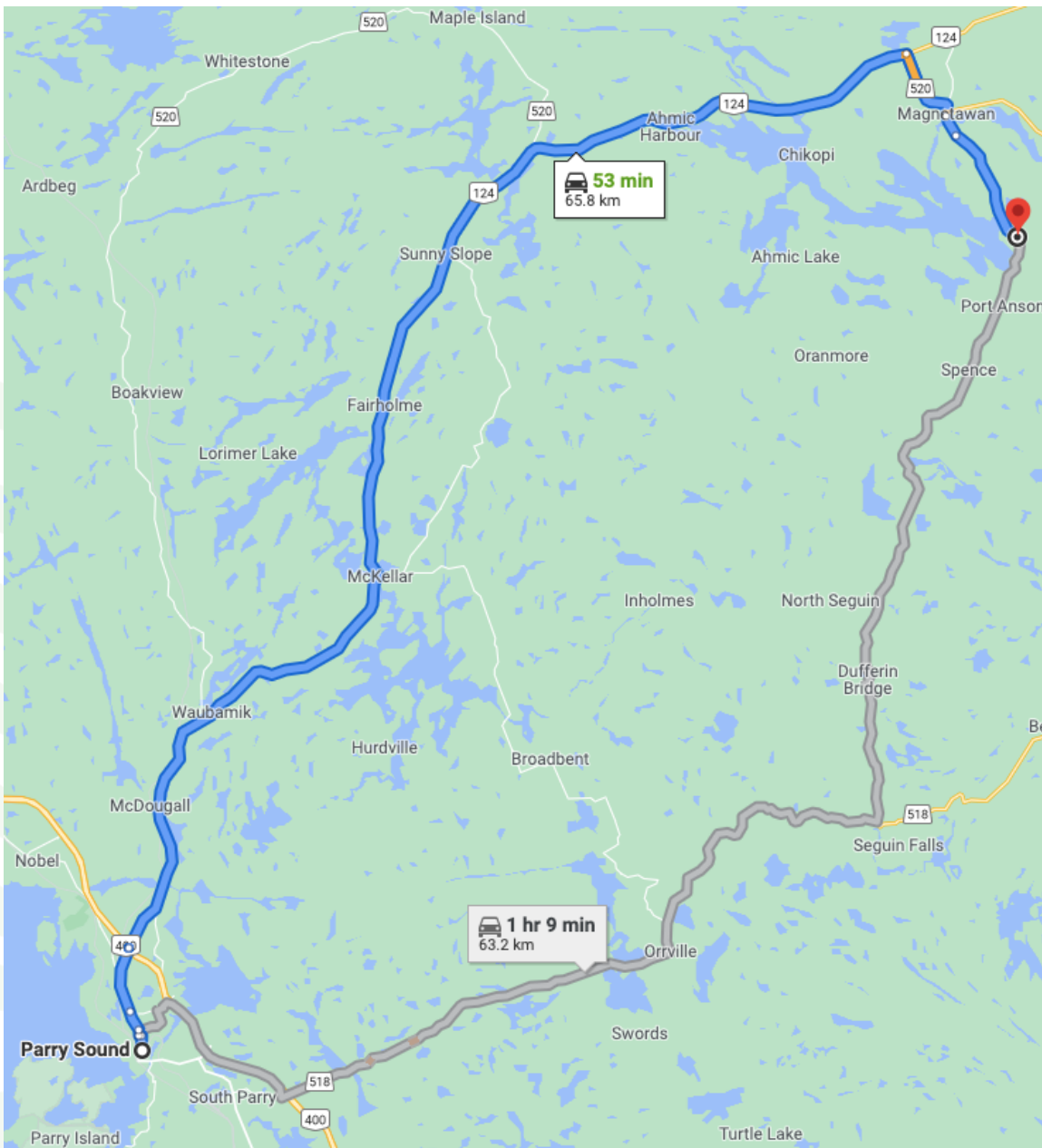


There are two ways to get to Camp Kahquah from southern Ontario. Go north on Highway 400 until you get to Barrie. On the north side of Barrie, the highway splits. You can choose to either go north up Highway 400 to Parry Sound, or you can take Highway 11 north through Huntsville. Here are directions using both of those routes.



Parry Sound

Hwy 400 north to Parry Sound – Take exit 231 for Hwy 124 to Sundridge off of Hwy 400. Go east (turn right) onto 124, drive approx. 35 minutes. Turn right onto 520 south to Magnetawan (the Bait & Tackle store is on the corner) and continue down this road. At the 4-way stop in town, go straight through and across the bridge; this becomes Nipissing Rd. Follow this out of town approx. 5 mins. There is a “Caution – Park Entrance Ahead” sign posted just before our hill. We are two thirds down this hill on the right.



Huntsville

Hwy 11 north to Huntsville – Follow Hwy 11 north past Huntsville to Burk's Falls. Exit at Hwy 520 and Ferguson Rd (exit 257), turning right onto 520 at the top of the ramp. Drive through town, over the bridge, and follow 520 immediately turning left after the bridge. Stay on this road through to Magnetawan (approx. 15 mins). At the 4-way stop, turn left and cross the bridge. This is Nipissing Rd. Follow this out of town approx. 5 mins. There is a "Caution – Park Entrance Ahead" sign posted just before our hill. We are two thirds down this hill on the right.
